Lunch

Once again, we will be welcoming parents into school to have lunch with the children. On **Wednesday 2nd October at 12.15pm** parents of children in Year 6 are invited to join us. This is an opportunity for you to meet with the staff and the children, as well as experience the food on offer. If you want to come into school for lunch the expectation is that **you and your child** will have a school meal. Unfortunately, due to the logistics of ordering, **parents will be offered the hot meal option only**.
